As mathematicians, we will:

- More than, fewer than, same

Develop their phonological awareness, so that they can:

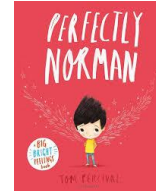
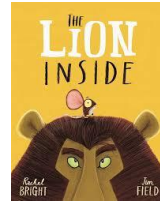
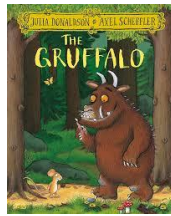
- spot and suggest rhymes

To develop our personal, social and emotional skills, we will:

- Select and use activities and resources, with help when needed, to help them achieve a goal they have chosen, or one which is suggested to them
- Develop their sense of responsibility and membership of a community

To develop our physical skills, we will:

- Continue to develop their movement, balancing, riding and ball skills.
- Use large-muscle movements to wave flags and streamers, paint and make marks.
- Match their developing physical skills to tasks and activities in the setting.
- Use one-handed tools and equipment, for example, making snips in paper with scissors.
- Be increasingly independent as they get dressed and undressed
