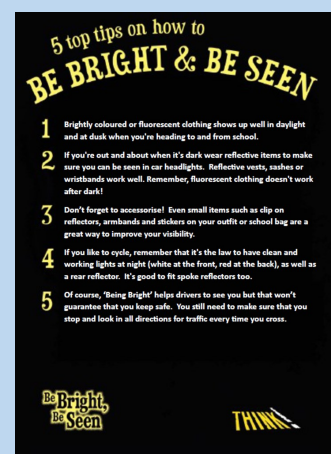
Secondary School Admissions Process

The statutory national closing date for applications is 31st October 2022. Applications can be made online via www.essex.gov.uk/admissions
