### Secondary School Admissions Process

As you may be aware, the new secondary school admission round opened on **12<sup>th</sup> September 2022**, for parents of current Year 6 children to apply for a secondary school (Year 7) place for September 2023.

The statutory national closing date for applications is 31st October 2022. Applications can be made online via [www.essex.gov.uk/admissions](http://www.essex.gov.uk/admissions)

All of the application information is available on the website above. **Please ensure that you have logged onto the website and have made an application by the closing date of 31<sup>st</sup> October 2022.**

Should you require any help with applying for a school place, please do not hesitate to contact the school office.

## Breakfast and Afterschool club

Breakfast club runs from 7.45 a.m. until 8.40 a.m. and costs £2.50 per day, or alternatively £10.00 per full week, if paid for in advance.

After School Club for our children runs from 3:15 p.m. until 5:30 p.m. Monday to Friday and costs £6.00 per day or £25.00 per full week. If paid for in advance.

Both breakfast and afterschool clubs are currently very busy and we are experiencing that spaces are being booked and children are not turning up, therefore other children are missing out on a space.

You need to inform the school office at least 24hours prior that the space is no longer required **or you will still be charged.**

Payments can be made online via Pay360 or cash in the office.
