If you would like to donate any books to the school, for our school library, please hand these into the school office throughout the week. Donations are very much appreciated but please ensure that these are in good condition.



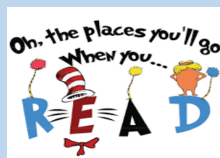

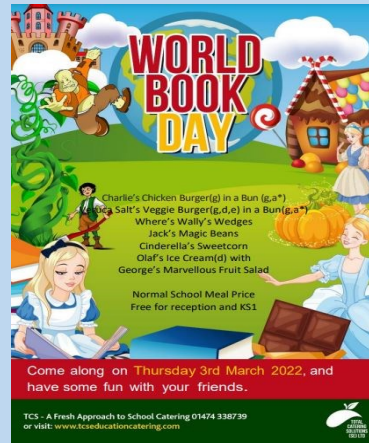
