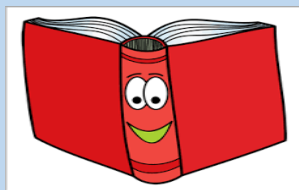

Please ensure your child is reading everyday and that they are returning to school each day with their books and diaries.

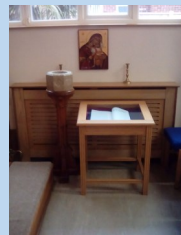
Parents/carers are encouraged to record any reading you do with your children.
