- ⇒ Pick up on disrespectful behaviour and educate our pupils as to why

Secondary School Admissions Process

As you may be aware, the new secondary school admission round opened on **10th September 2021**, for parents of current Year 6 children to apply for a secondary school (Year 7) place for September 2022..

The statutory national closing date for applications is 31st October 2021. Applications can be made online via www.essex.gov.uk/admissions.

All of the application information is available on the website above. **Please ensure that you have logged onto the website and have made an application by the closing date of 31st October 2021.**

Should you require any help with applying for a school place, please do not hesitate to contact the school office.

COVID 19 Guidance

All absences need to be reported to the school office each morning that the child is unwell. If your child has one of the 3 symptoms i.e. temperature, new consistent cough, change in taste or smell then please seek guidance from NHS 119 and email the school, admin@lubbinspark.essex.sch.uk with the outcome of this call. If your child has done a PCR test or is undertaking one then please email over their PCR test result as soon as you receive it. Please be advised that Primary Schools **do not accept** Lateral Flow Test results as they are not applicable to primary school children and are not accepted if children already have symptoms.

This is due to the immediate requirement to deliver the healthy child COVID-19 vaccination programme for 12-15 year olds.
