Communication between home and school

- We will only contact you if we need to.
- This change has come from parent feedback last year and what other local schools do.
- If your child has a mark on them, from an incident, we will contact you.
- A text message will be sent when your child has received first aid.
- We will not contact you over small friendship issues, these are resolved in school.
- You will receive a notification through Trackit if your child receives a 2 or 3.
- If you would like to speak to your child's class teacher, please email the office to organise a phone call.
- Please ensure that emails are only sent to the admin email account. These will then be triaged. Communication will only be through emails or calls. **We will not be accepting letters / notes as a communication tool this year.**

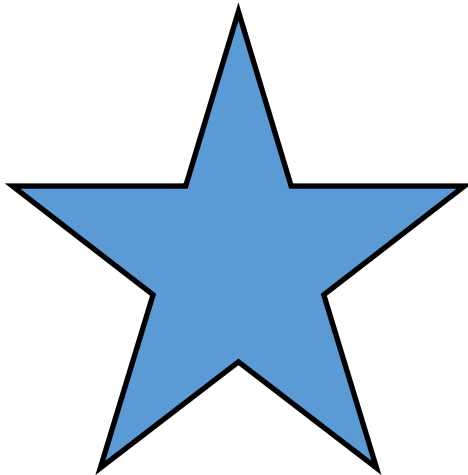

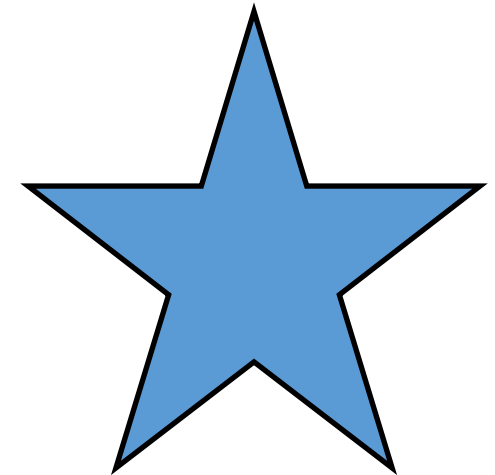
