Easter Bonnet Parade

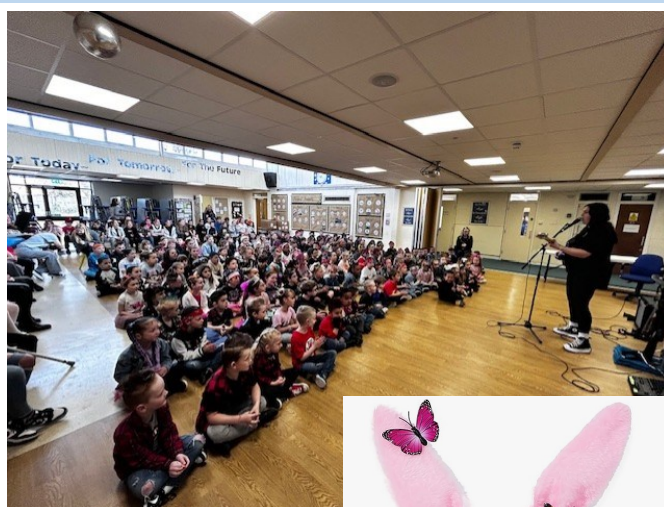
Please create an Easter Bonnet with your child to parade in assembly on Friday 4th April.
