They were in awe of the temple: its carpets, decoration, attention to detail!

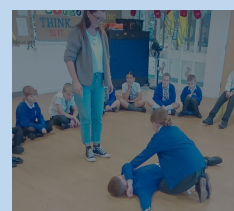


The trip was so popular that we have booked another trip for the 26th June. Please contact the school office if you would like your child to experience this trip in June.
