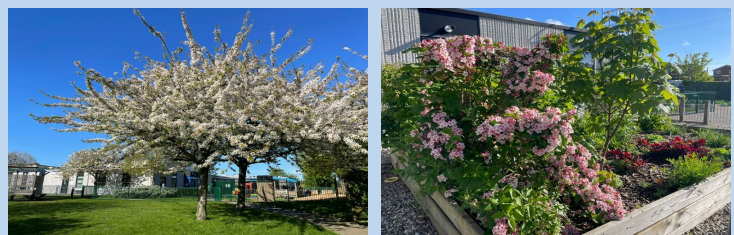


Swimming
