An update from Mrs Murrell

This week, the children have started to think about kindness and what it means to them. On Monday, we will be celebrating World Kindness Day. This is a perfect way to start the week, as it is Anti Bullying week. We will be discussing themes around bullying and how to prevent it. When talking to your children at home about bullying, please refer to the acronym: STOP! Bullying is: **Several Times On Purpose**. What should they do? Start Telling Other People.

Children will be taking part in an assembly and lessons on anti-bullying throughout the week. We will be promoting the phrase: 'Everyone is different, and that's ok'. We will be celebrating being unique and having individual qualities. Anti-bullying wrist bands will be available to purchase for £1.00 after school, all week.

To mark **World Kindness Day**, the children have written on blue and yellow hearts, either to their friends, explaining what kindness means to them or words about kindness. These will be displayed in the windows around the school next week.

In addition to **World Kindness Day**, we will be taking part in **Maths Week**. Mrs Davis has set the children a challenge over the weekend to do as many maths related activities as possible and share these with her next week. This could be working out change, seeing shapes outdoors, doing some baking or measuring the ingredients. I look forward to hearing about these next week.

Over the weekend, our **PLT** will be attending the poppy services on the island with Miss Carlton and myself. All of the children have taken part in a live Remembrance service today at school and reflected on the importance of marking this day in history. If you are attending a remembrance service over the weekend, please do encourage your child to talk about this at school on Monday.

The dinner menu for week commencing 13.11.2023 will be: **Week 3 ORANGE** from the **Autumn/Winter** menu.

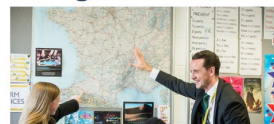
School dinners cost £2.40 per child per day and payment should be made via School Gateway.
